

## How To Find Out Your Version Of Photoshop?

Installing Photoshop plugins was not an automated process in the past. But with the newest Photoshop CC update, 2021, we can now double click an installer and this will install Raya Pro automatically.

If you're using older versions of Photoshop, the installation process is still not complicated as it requires just copying and pasting some folders.

Please check your version carefully to make sure you're installing the correct version. Otherwise, Raya Pro will not work.

### Finding Your Version

**Windows users:** go into the top menu in Photoshop called 'Help' and then to 'About Photoshop'.

**Mac users:** go into the top menu named 'Photoshop', and then to 'About Photoshop'.



A pop up will appear like the one above. The version number is in the top left. See below for what the version means and which folder to install Raya Pro from.

- **Version 22.0.0.0** (or similar – 22.1.0.0 for example) is the latest version, also known as Photoshop 2021. Please go into the **CC 2021 folder** and install Raya Pro by double clicking on the installer there.
- **Version 13 is CS6**. Please go into the **CS6 Users folder** and watch the installation video there to install the panel.
- **Version 16 to 21 are older versions of CC**. Please go into the **Old CC (2017-2020)** folder and watch the installation video to install Raya Pro. HOWEVER, we encourage you to update to the latest version of Photoshop, which is free to CC subscribers, and that way you can use the double click installer in **CC 2021 folder**.
